



What's it all about?

Every week I will be adding a 'washcloth' to the collection.

For each washcloth **YOU WILL NEED** oddments of DK weight cotton yarn, a 3.50 mm hook and a needle for neatening ends.

When worked at gauge, each washcloth will measure 8" square.

As an alternative to cotton, why not use a softer yarn - make a square a week and join into a blanket or throw! I'll even try to give the repeat so you can make them smaller/larger to suit.

HINT: If you're planning on joining several together, leave approximately 60 cm (24") of yarn to the start and the finish for later. You may not need it but, better to be safe than sorry!

Make sure you download the updated pattern every now and then to get the full collection.



WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 1



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: ss in 2nd ch from hook, 1htr in next st, (ss in next ch, 1htr in next ch) across, turn.

Row 2: 1ch, ss in first st, 1htr in next st, (ss in next st, 1htr in next st) across, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1hdc in next st, (sl st in next ch, 1hdc in next ch) across, turn.

Row 2: 1ch, sl st in first st, 1hdc in next st, (sl st in next st, 1hdc in next st) across, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 2



GAUGE: 19sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (1dc, 1htr) in 3rd ch from hook, *miss next ch, (1dc, 1htr) in next ch, rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: 1ch, miss first dc, (1dc, 1htr) in next dc, *miss next dc, (1dc, 1htr) in next st, rep from * across, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (1sc, 1hdc) in 3rd ch from hook, *skip next ch, (1sc, 1hdc) in next ch, rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: 1ch, skip first sc, (1sc, 1hdc) in next sc, *skip next sc, (1sc, 1hdc) in next st, rep from * across, turn.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 3



GAUGE: 17sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 35ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (1tr, 1dc) in 3rd ch from hook, *tr2tog over next 2ch, 1dc in same ch as 2nd part of tr2tog, rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: 1ch, 1htr in each st across, turn - even st count.

Row 3: 1ch tr2tog over first two sts, 1dc in same st as 2nd part of tr2tog, *tr2tog over next 2sts, 1dc in same st as 2nd part of tr2tog, rep from * to end, turn.

Repeat Row 2 & 3 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 35ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (1dc, 1sc) in 3rd ch from hook, *dc2tog over next 2ch, 1sc in same ch as 2nd part of dc2tog, rep from * to end, turn.


Row 2: 1ch, 1hdc in each st across, turn - even st count.

Row 3: 1ch dc2tog over first two sts, 1dc in same st as 2nd part of dc2tog, *dc2tog over next 2sts, 1sc in same st as 2nd part of dc2tog, rep from * to end, turn.

Repeat Row 2 & 3 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 4 - not so knobbly this week but, nice for a facecloth, perhaps!?!



YOU WILL NEED: oddments of DK weight cotton yarn, a 3.50 mm hook and a needle for neatening ends.

GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 40ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: 2dc in 2nd ch from hook, *miss next st, 2dc in next st), rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: Miss first st, 2dc in next st, *miss next st, 2dc in next st, rep from * across, turn - even st count.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 40ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: 2sc in 2nd ch from hook, *skip next st, 2sc in next st), rep from * to end, turn.

Row 2: Skip first st, 2sc in next st, *skip next st, 2sc in next st, rep from * across, turn - even st count.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 5



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

Double UK dc (Ddc)/Double US sc (Dsc): For those familiar with making a decrease, you will notice that this st is worked as a UK dc/US sc decrease but instead of using the next 2sts, you will use the **previous** st for the first part and the **next** st for the second part. Insert hook into same place as **previous** st worked and draw up a loop (2 loops on hook), insert hook into **next** st and draw up a loop (3 loops on hook), draw yarn through all loops on hook. **Note:** Although the st appears to be a dc2tog, there is no decrease in st count.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) 1dc in each ch to end, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, (use first and second stitches to make initial Ddc), Ddc to end, 1dc in last st - this st is very important for keeping the st count correct, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.


US PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) 1sc in each ch to end, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, (use first and second stitches to make initial Dsc), Dsc to end, 1sc in last st - this st is very important for keeping the st count correct, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 40ch (add/subtract multiples of 3ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *dc2tog, 2htr in next ch, rep from * to end, turn - 39 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, *dc2tog, 2htr in next st, rep from * across, turn - 39 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 40ch (add/subtract multiples of 3ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *sc2tog, 2hdc in next ch, rep from * to end, turn - 39 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, *sc2tog, 2hdc in next st, rep from * across, turn - 39 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 7 (worked corner to corner)



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with (1ch, 3dc) into a magic ring (<http://thomasinacummings.co.uk/double-loop-magic-ring/>).

Row 1: Place a st marker in the 2nd of 3dc, turn - 3sts.

Row 2: 1ch, 1dc in each st to marker, 3dc in marked st, re-place marker in 2nd of 3dc, 1dc in each remaining st to end, turn - an increase of 2sts.

Repeat Row 2 until there are 32sts either side of marker, each side is 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with (1ch, 3sc) into a magic ring (<http://thomasinacummings.co.uk/double-loop-magic-ring/>).

Row 1: Place a st marker in the 2nd of 3sc, turn - 3sts.

Row 2: 1ch, 1sc in each st to marker, 3sc in marked st, re-place marker in 2nd of 3sc, 1sc in each remaining st to end, turn - an increase of 2sts.

Repeat Row 2 until there are 32sts either side of marker, each side is 20 cm (8") long or as desired.



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *dc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2ch, dc2tog, 1 further dc in final ch, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, *(working in BLO) dc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2sts, (working in BLO) dc2tog, 1 further dc in final st, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *sc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2ch, sc2tog, 1 further sc in final ch, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, *(working in BLO) sc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2sts, (working in BLO) sc2tog, 1 further sc in final st, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 9



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *dc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2ch, dc2tog, 1 further dc in final ch, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, *dc2tog inserting hook through both loops of first st (or into ch-1 sp if you find it easier) and FLO of next st, 1ch, rep from * to last 2sts, dc2tog using both loops of first st (or into ch-1 sp as before) and FLO of next st, 1 further dc in final st, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *sc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2ch, sc2tog, 1 further sc in final ch, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, * sc2tog inserting hook through both loops of first st (or into ch-1 sp if you find it easier) and FLO of next st, 1ch, rep from * to last 2sts, sc2tog both loops of first st (or into ch-1 sp as before) and FLO of next st, 1 further sc in final st, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

WASHCLOTH WEDNESDAY

WEEK 10



GAUGE: 20sts to 10 cm (4") in pattern.

SPECIAL STITCH: dc-htr2tog (US sc-hdc2tog) - insert hook in next ch/st and draw up a loop, yrh (yo), insert hook into next ch/st and draw up a loop, draw yarn through 4 loops on hook.

UK PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 1: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *dc-htr2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2ch, dc-htr2tog, 1 further htr in final ch, turn - 40 sts.

Row 2: 1ch, *dc-htr2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2sts, dc-htr2tog (using ch-1 sp and next st), 1 further htr in final st, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.

US PATTERN

Commence with 41ch (add/subtract multiples of 2ch to vary width).

Row 3: (Starting in 2nd ch from hook) *sc-hdc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2ch, sc-hdc2tog, 1 further hdc in final ch, turn - 40 sts.

Row 4: 1ch, * sc-hdc2tog, 1ch, rep from * to last 2sts, sc-hdc2tog (using ch-1 sp and next st), 1 further hdc in final st, turn - 40 sts.

Repeat Row 2 until piece measures 20 cm (8") long or as desired.
